# NATIONAL CIRCUMSTANCES



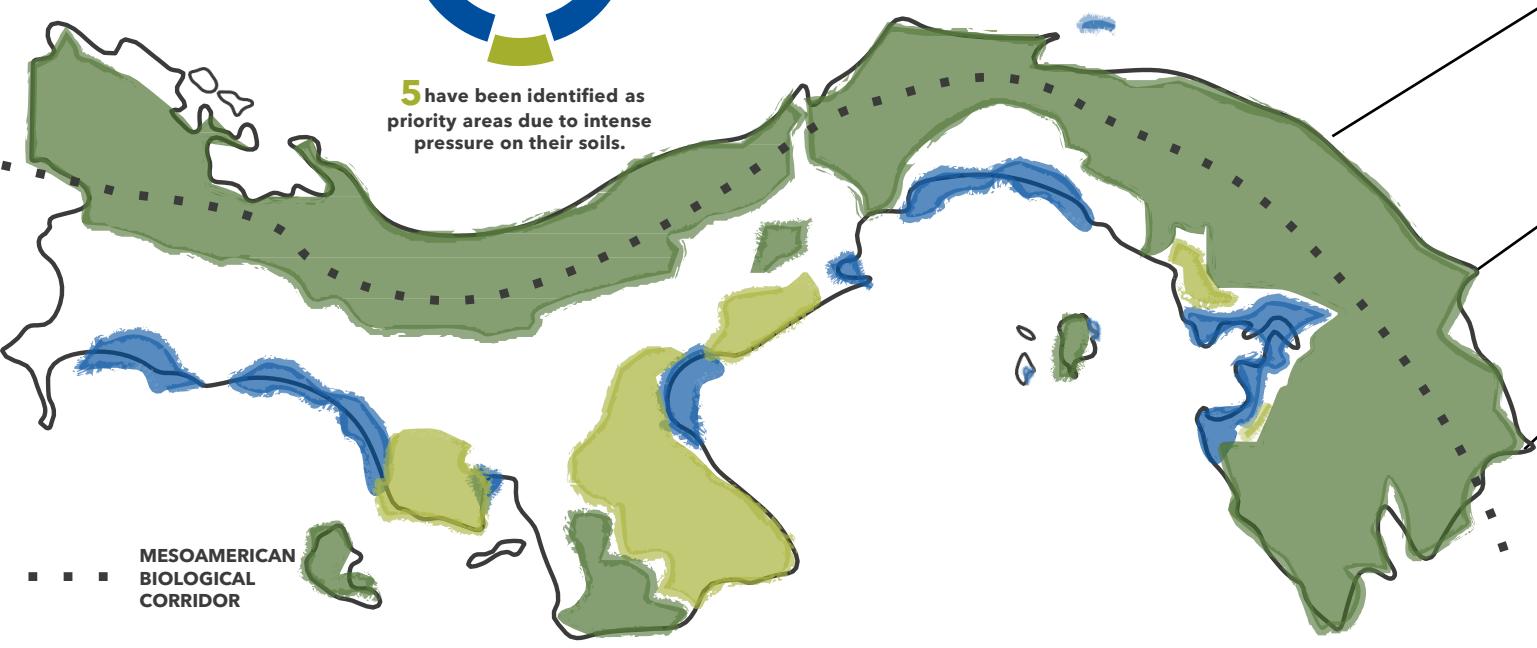
**5** have been identified as priority areas due to intense pressure on their soils.

- +32% PROTECTED LAND AREA

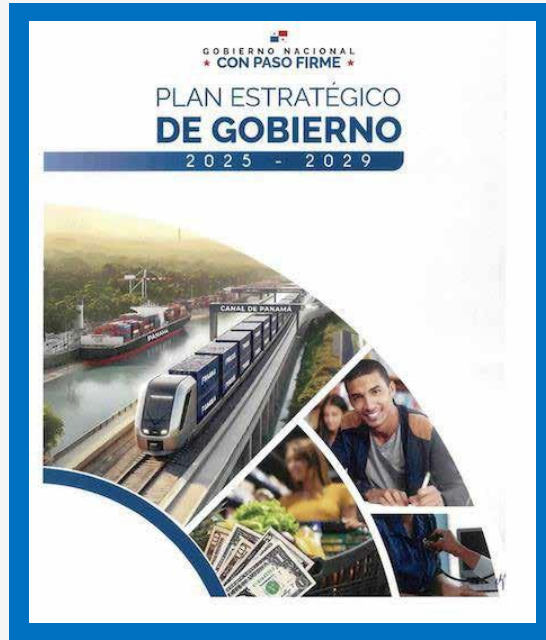

# NATURE PLEDGE

## What is it?

Unified framework that integrates, in accordance with the multilateral system and national realities, our international obligations and goals on climate change, biodiversity, and the fight against desertification, plastics, marine and terrestrial conservation, to present them as a single country plan with clarity and transparency.

## Scope

It focuses exclusively on establishing the goals, pillars, and commitments that will govern the environmental agenda and priorities in the next decade.

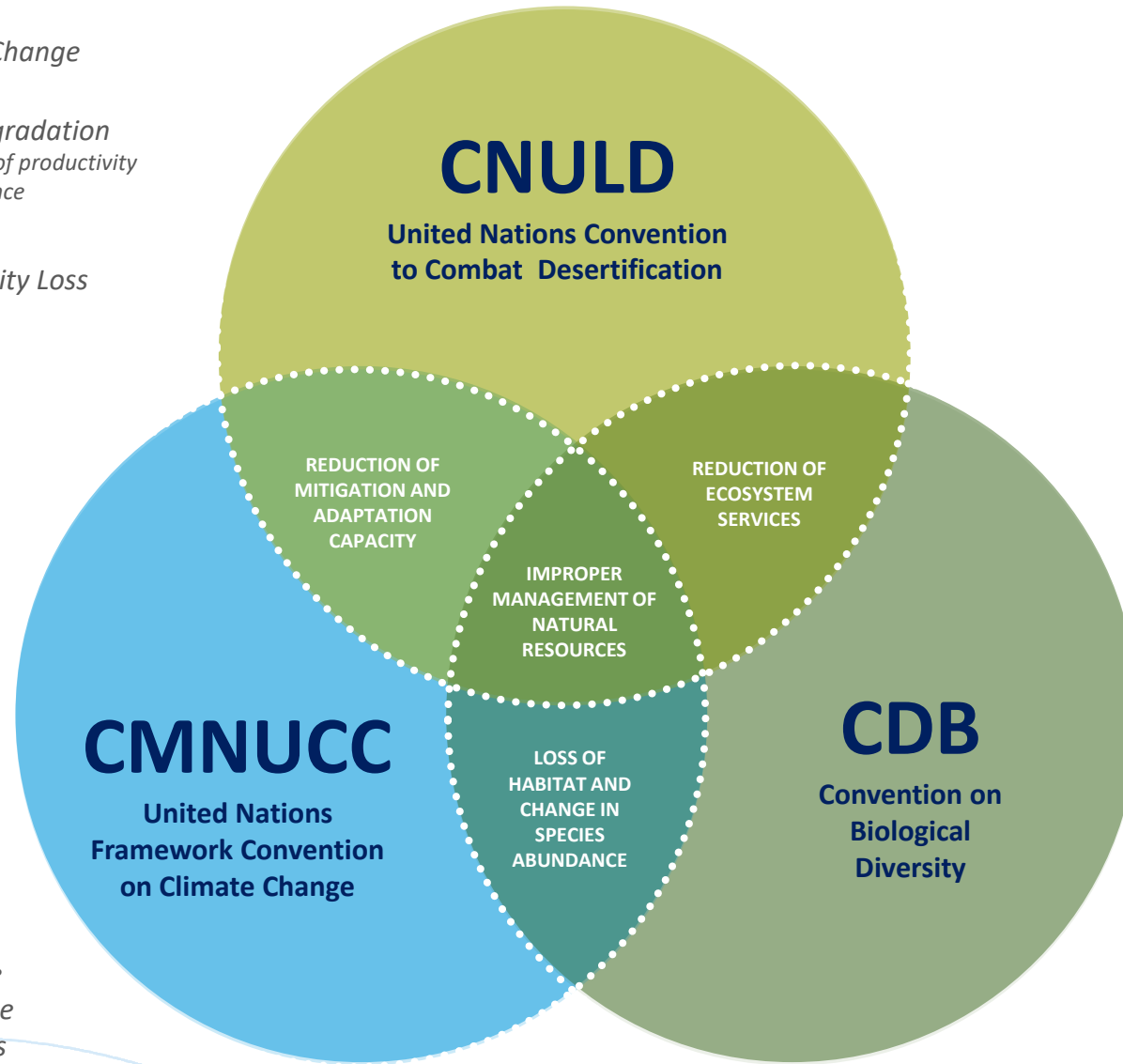

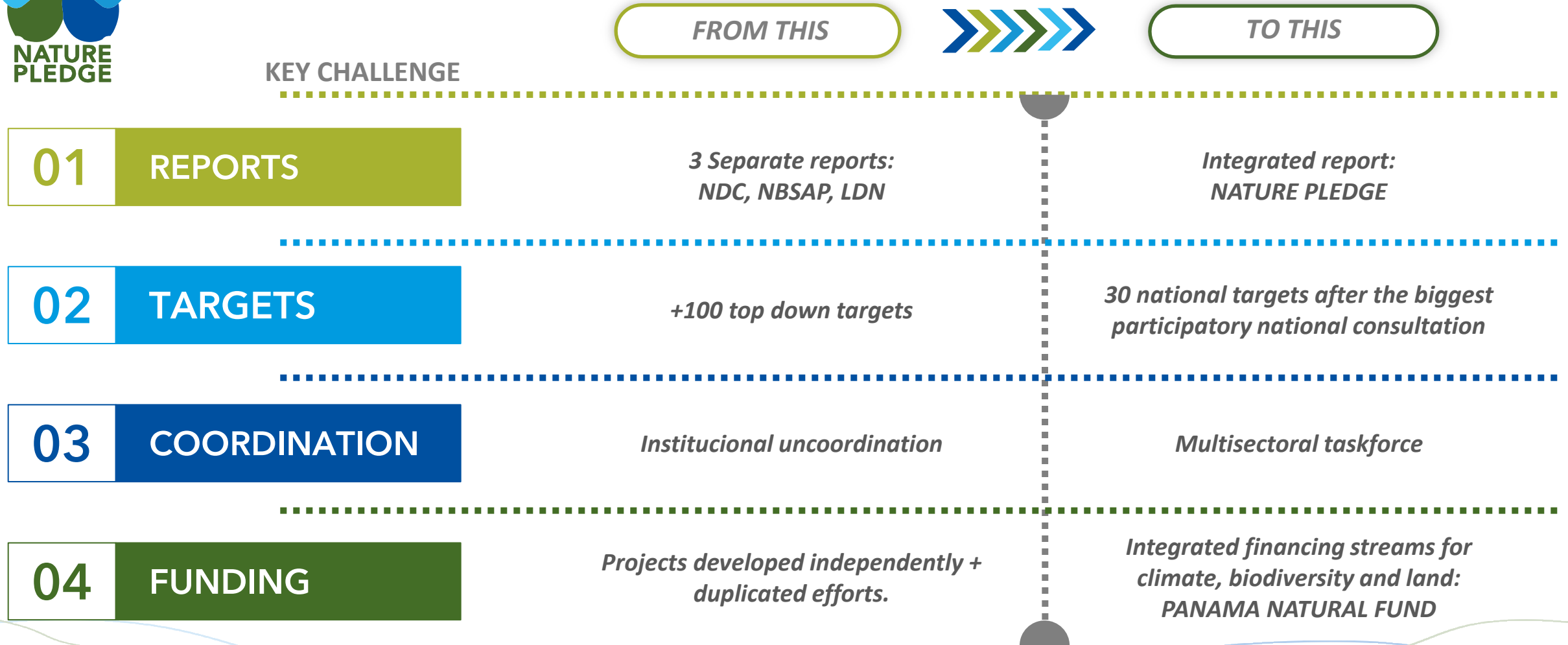

### Restoration of 100,000

Strategic ecosystems to recover ecosystem services (including 2,500 ha of mangroves and 25,000 productive hectares)

### ZERO Illegal Deforestation

Implementation of a National Forest Traceability and Control System with coverage across 100% of concessions and permits.

### Financial Alignment

Mobilize at least USD 300 million toward synergistic climate, biodiversity, and land actions.

### 30% Urban Spaces

Increase green and blue infrastructure in cities, integrating climate and biodiversity criteria

### Increased and Effective Protected Areas

National parks rehabilitated and operating under the highest international standards.

### 11%

Reduction of greenhouse gas emissions in energy, agriculture, industry, and waste

### Waste Reduction

Progressively reduce solid waste sent to final disposal and food waste..

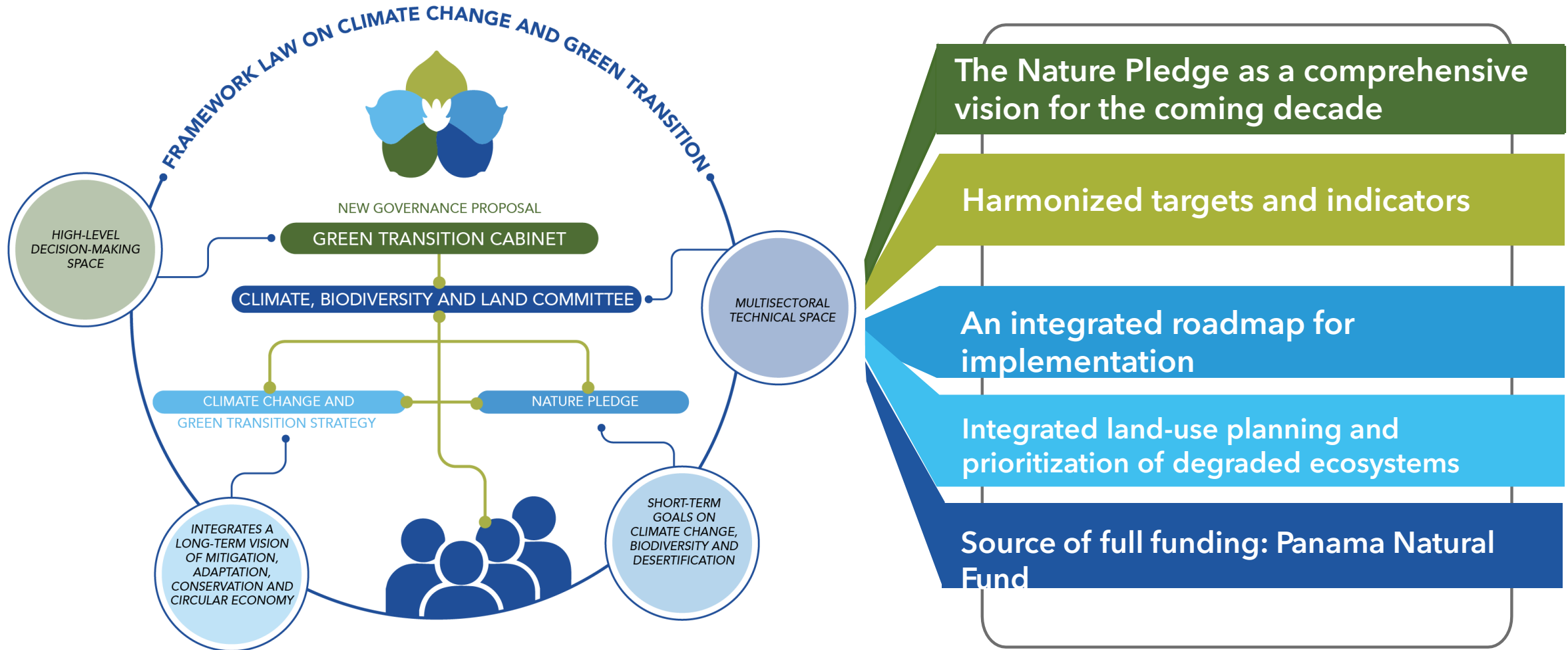

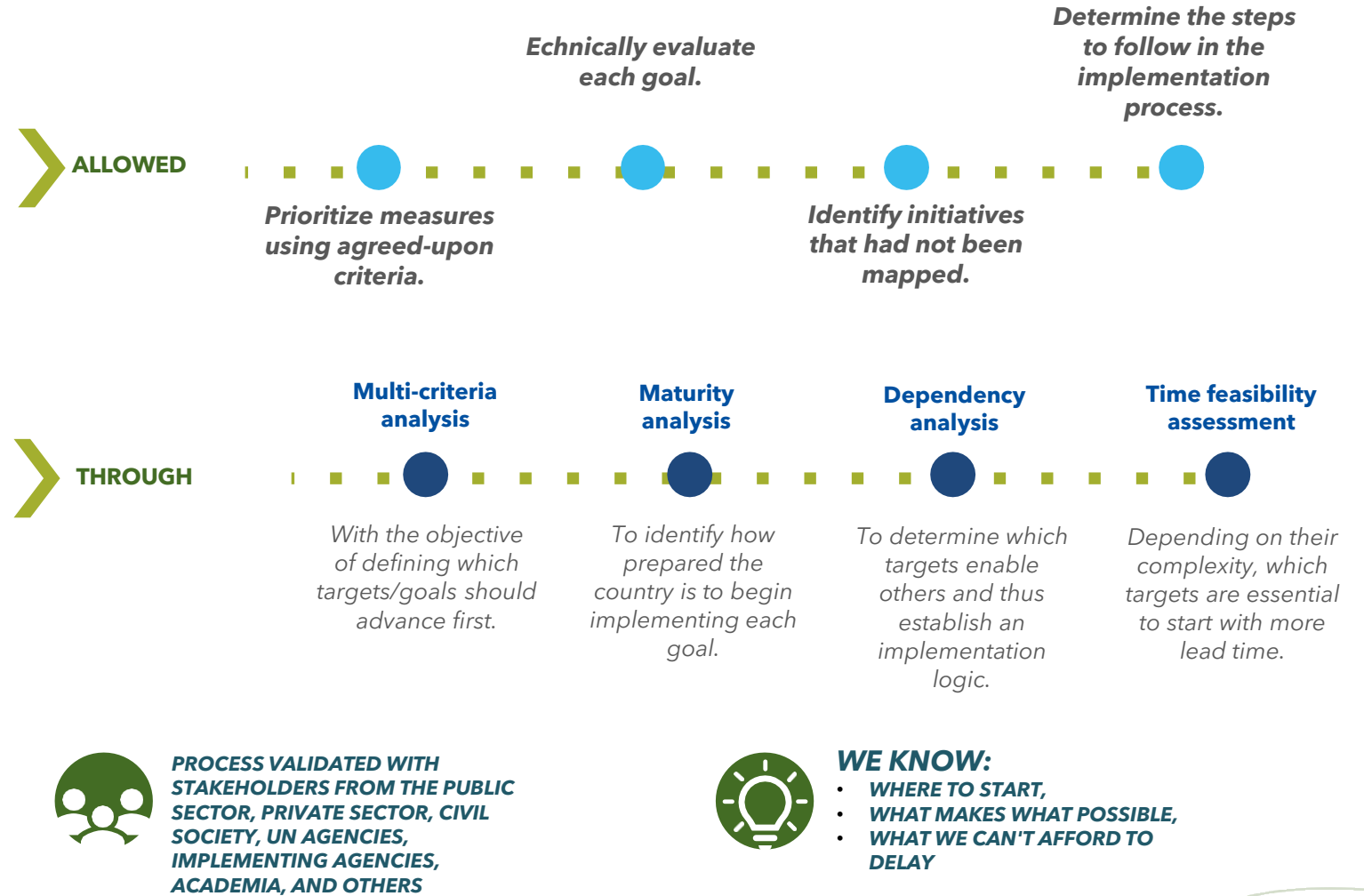

## 1. MULTILATERAL INTERNATIONAL FUNDS

*The main relevant mechanisms include:*

- Green Climate Fund (GCF)
- Global Environment Facility (GEF)
- Adaptation Fund
- Climate funds and windows of multilateral development banks
- Financial mechanisms of multilateral environmental agreements.

## 2. BILATERAL COOPERATION AND INTERNATIONAL INITIATIVES

*A trust fund established through the mobilization of funds and institutional arrangements driven by the PFP process.*

## 3. REFORESTA FUND

*It is recognized as a national tool designed to support restoration, reforestation, and sustainable landscape management efforts, with the potential to contribute to goals related to ecosystem recovery, carbon sequestration, and the strengthening of sustainable livelihoods.*

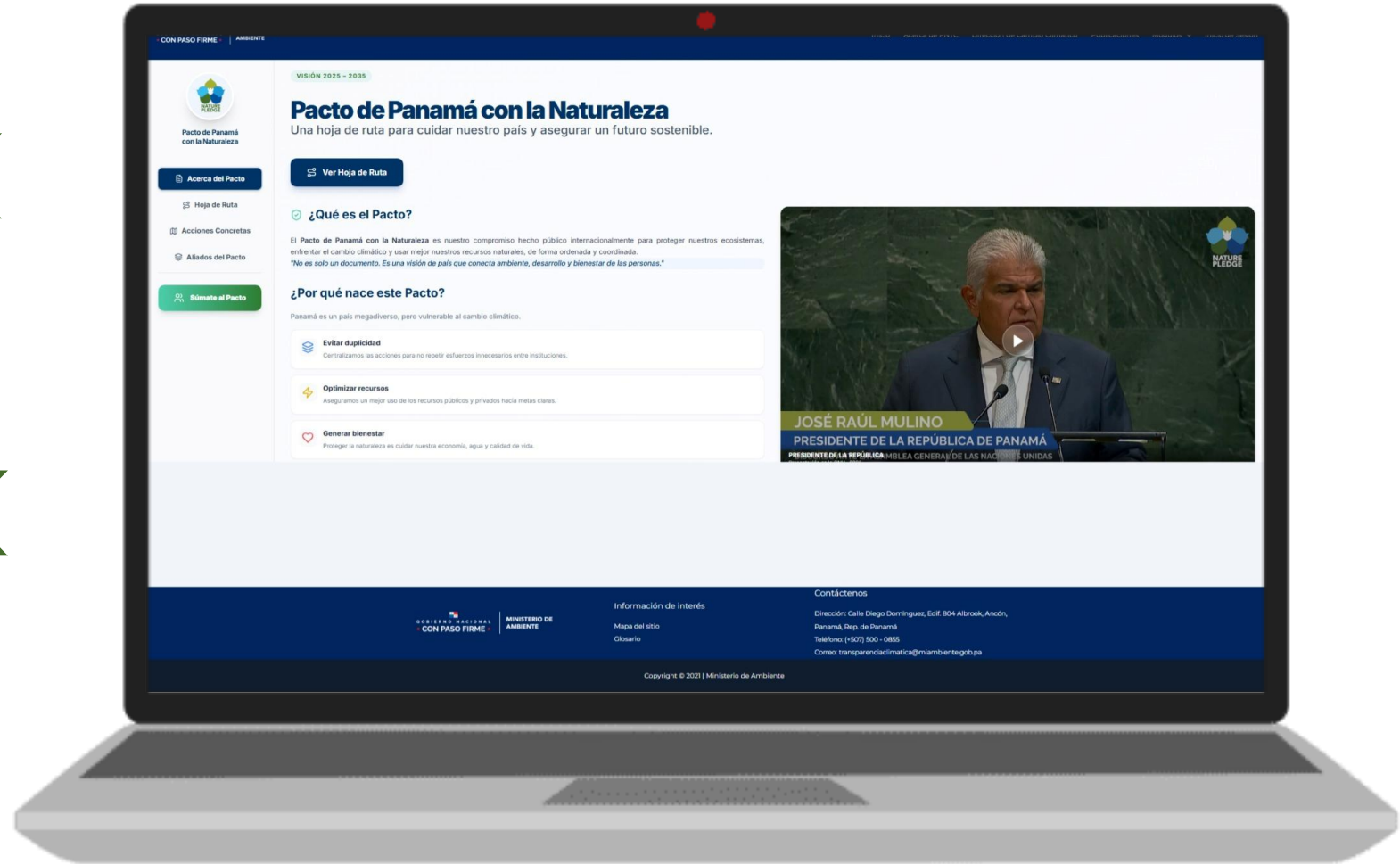

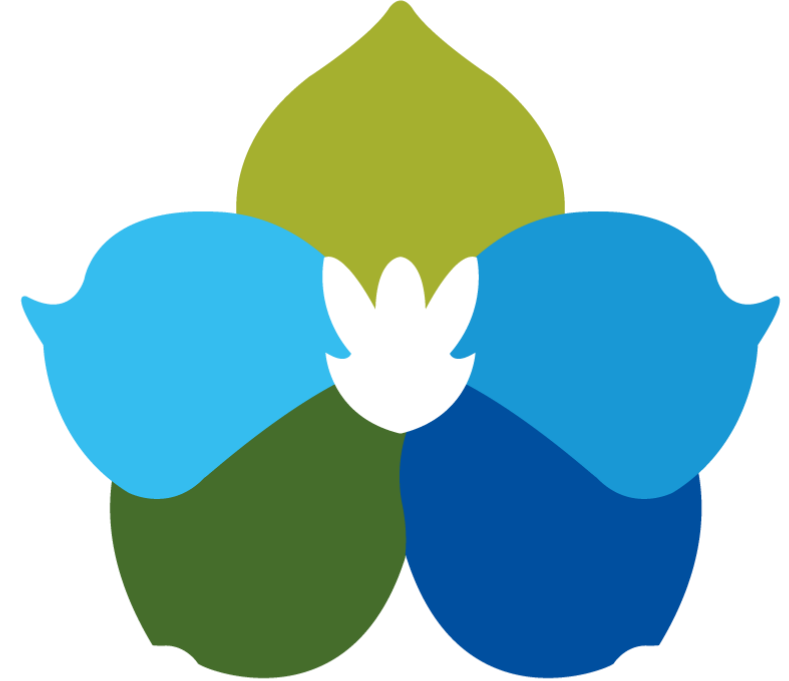
